Submitting sample for DNA Testing

When pulling hair samples (DNA samples) take care to obtain 20-30 hair FOLLICLES (hair roots). This is very important! Coarse, longer hair found over withers, chest, rump, tail or back of hind leg is the preferred sample type. Needle-nosed pliers work well for this job. Hair sample must be sealed inside a 3.5" x 6.5" paper envelope. Do not use plastic bags. Put goat's name and eartag number on the outside of the envelope. Send hair sample with this DNA request form.
